Gamer Garage Sale Policies

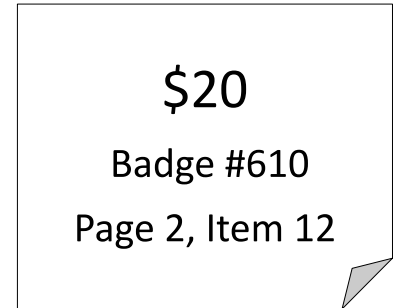
Fixed Price Sales

What is Fixed Price Selling at the Gamer Garage Sale?

Gamer Garage Sale Fixed Price Sales provide an opportunity for attendees to sell used games and gaming-related items to convention attendees at a fixed price. This includes **books**, **puzzles**, and **miniatures**.

Selling Fixed Price Items

- To sell items, fill out a Gamer Garage Sale Seller Sheet
- You **must** have a convention badge to sell items in the Gamer Garage Sale
- Create a price tag with the provided sticky notepad. Include price, badge number, and item number (include the page number if multiple pages)
- Prices must be in dollar increments
- Prices can be changed after listing (relisted) by contacting staff and relabeling price stickers
- Items can be grouped to sell as a bundle (e.g. set of minis, game w/ expansions, dice, etc.)

Buying Fixed Price Items

- It is Caveat Emptor, but if you have questions ask
- We take major credit/debit cards and cash; no checks
- To buy items, you **must** have a convention badge to buy items from the Gamer Garage Sale

Checking Out and Getting Paid

To check out the Gamer Garage Sale, visit the register anytime before 2pm on Sunday. The sale is open from 9am to 6pm, or later if volunteers are available. You can collect your unsold items and get paid for your sold ones. You will receive a Gamer Garage Sale Checkout slip, which you can exchange for cash at the Registration on desk.

DEADLINE 2 pm Sunday

The Gamer Garage Sale closes at 2pm Sunday, and all items **MUST** be picked up by that time. Make arrangements in advance if needed. Items left unclaimed become the property of TsunamiCon, organizers of the convention.

15% Commission

TsunamiCon keeps a 15% commission from your total sales to support the convention.

Example: If the asking price for your sold items totals \$25.00, you will receive \$21.25, as TsunamiCon keeps 15% (\$3.75). Where possible we will round to the nearest quarter.

Fine Print

All items are sold as-is, and TsunamiCon takes no responsibility for any missing pieces, damaged, or otherwise undesirable items

All sales are final and not subject to refund

No special 'game' mechanics for sellers to adjust price on-the-fly

The convention staff will determine if an item, bundle of goods, etc. meets the requirements, and reserves the right to accept or refuse items that do not meet the criteria or break the spirit of the sale

TsunamiCon takes no responsibility for products damaged, misplaced, or mislabeled at the Gamer Garage Sale; TsunamiCon watches for shoplifting, sticker swapping, and other mischief but cannot guarantee security for your items

The purpose of these policies is to enhance security, ensure compliance with the tax code, and maintain transparency on all matters as a service to TsunamiCon organizers, volunteers, and staff..
